Today the company employs ten permanent staff. Mr Andreas Poulsen is the CEO and owner of the company, which he operates together with his wife, Poula, who is also the bookkeeper and administers the daily office work.

The company has its own mechanical workshop with one fulltime employee.

AP Busskoyring offers a wide variety of services, among them the transport of disabled people from door to door with specialised vehicles.

They also offer to transport smaller and larger groups of

people, both domestically and abroad, including a driver.

They are also capable of organising tours, both domestically and abroad.

Apart from all the above, they hold a contract with Strand-faraskip Landsins (the National Ferry & Transport Company) to operate the bus routes no's 410, 500, 504 and 506.

AP Busskoyring has thirteen various busses in three various classes. Their largest bus will seat 56 passengers. They have several busses, which will seat 52 passengers, one specialised bus for 42 passengers, which also has a lift for disabled people. They have busses, which will seat both 20 and 15 passengers and several of them



have lifts for the disabled. Therefore, AP Busskoyring has the right bus for every occasion.

AP Busskoyring drives tourist groups, sightseeing trips, school groups, sports groups, specialised transport and a night service, both domestically and abroad. AP Busskoyring is a modern bus company, capable of resolving all types of transport requirements.
