This newly developed Baader 59 skinner, signals the beginning of a new generation of skinners. It is designed to process fillets tail first, with a minimum spacing of 10 cm. A separate pre-cut at the tail area ensures a perfect shallow skinning result, even at the tip of the tail. The Baader

59 automatically releases any fillets that hang by the collarbone. The machine can be fed manually or from a Baader 184, 185, 189, 200, 580. The speed can be adapted to all saddle machines. You achieve a straight fillet for further processing by a Baader 886 or on your candling table.
